Vygotsky Theory Explains Three Important Concepts

- ZPD (Zone of Proximal Development)
- MKO (The More Knowledgeable Other)
- Scaffolding

ZPD

It is actual gap what a child can do independently and what he can do with guidance.



MKO

- It refers to someone who has a better understanding or a higher ability level than learner
- Example: Teacher, Parents

Scaffolding

- Support
- Guidance
- Help
- Assisted Learning
