- At the age of 13, Virginia suffered from bouts of depression because of many deaths in her family.
- After her father's death, Virginia and her siblings move to Bloomsbury area of London.
- During this period Virginia came in contact with the intellectuals circle of that time.
- In 1912, she married Leonard Woolf.
- Vita Sackville West and her intimate friendship with her.

- Hogarth Press was founded in 1917 by Leonard and Virginia Woolf.
