

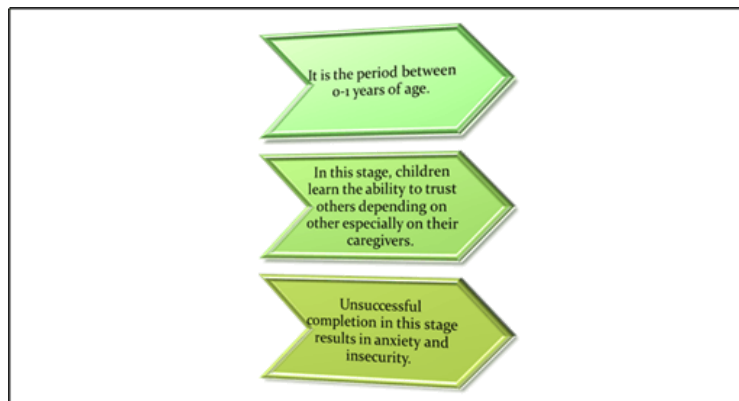

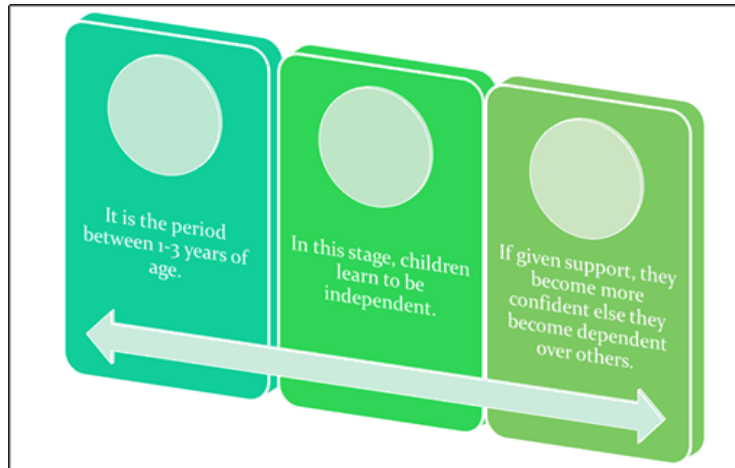
- Erikson's theory states that personality is groomed throughout lifetime.

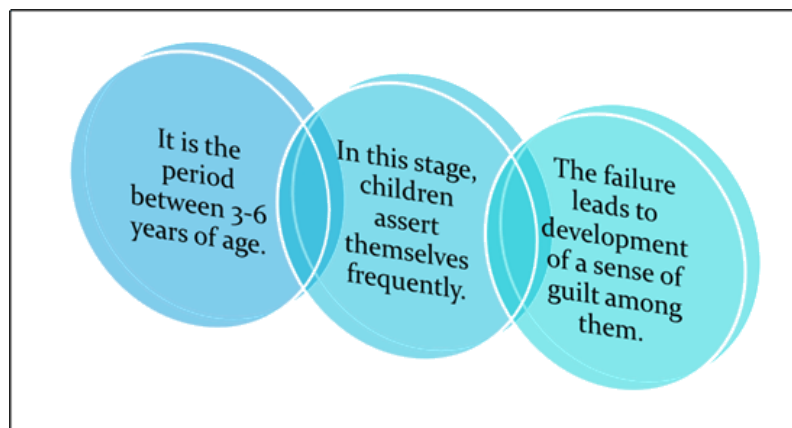

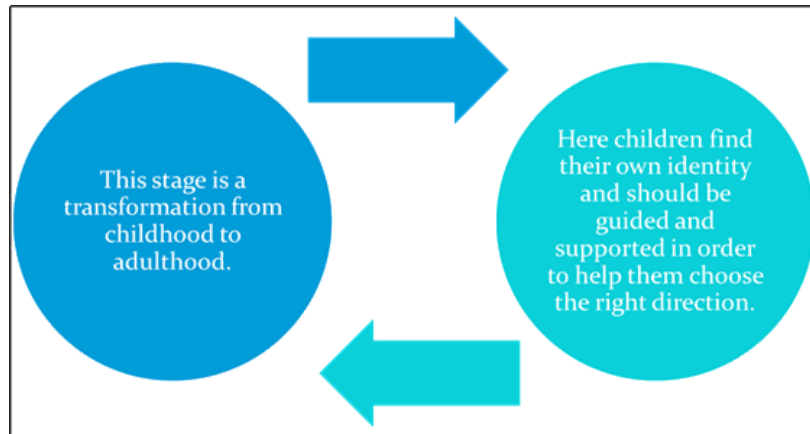

This stage is also known as young adulthood. Here, they begin to open up and become more intimate with others - Making close friends.

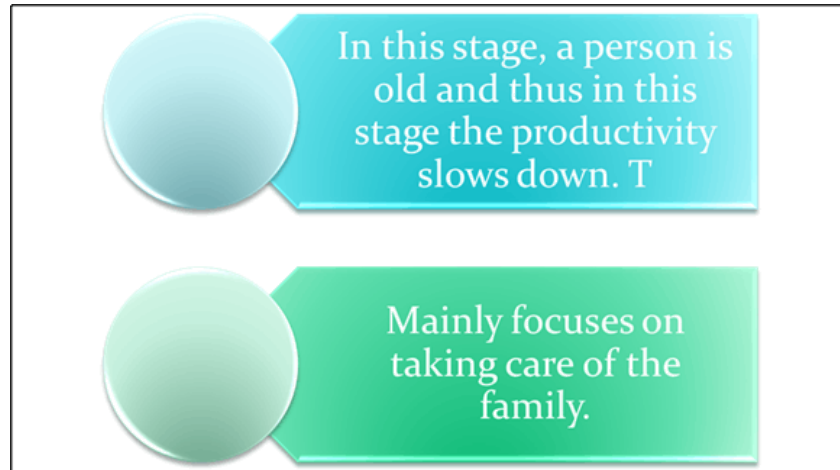
Adulthood
