- · Belonged to pre-Socratic philosophy.
- · The Greek meaning of Democritus is "chosen by people."
- Disciple of Leucippus.
- Philosophy of Atoms and void.
- Branches of Philosophy- Ethics, Aesthetics, Epistemology and Metaphysics.
- · Against Sophism.
- Nature of Knowledge- Mechanism and materialism.

Materialism

- Materialism = Matter is the sole reality.
- Nothing except matter exists.
- · Everything is composed of Atoms.
- Nature of Atoms physically indivisible and are imperishable.
- Therefore, atoms are always in motion.

Logical Atomism

- Nature consists of two Fundamental components; Atom and Void.
- Atoms are of different shape and size, indestructible, and surrounded by a void.
- They come together, they collide with each other and form clusters which give rise to various organisms in the world.

Aesthetics and Ethics

- Democritus established Aesthetics as a branch of philosophy in the Western study.
- He wrote a number of literary works, for example; On Poetry, On the beauty of Verses, On Rhythm and Harmony, On Songs, etc.
- · Soul is an aggregate of fiery atoms.
- Essence of atoms is fire.
- Present in us all, in everything around us.
- But most number of fiery atoms present in men.
- Happiness = gentle movement of Fiery atoms in us.
- True happiness = True friendship
- Note: True Happiness concept also discussed on similar lines in **Bhagvad Gita**.
