## Title: Modern Western Philosophy Kant

### The Critical Philosophy

- Rationalism and Empiricism are right in what they affirm.
- But wrong in what they deny.
- Debate between Rationalism and Empiricism.
- Kant says, Knowledge begins with experience but does not necessarily originate from it.
- **Knowledge begins with Sense; it proceeds to Understanding and ends in Reason.**

### Why Critical?

It is said as Critical philosophy because Kant goes beyond the dogmatic style and systems of philosophy.

### Forms of Sensibility

- In the absence of Space and Time nothing can be perceived.
- Mind has a faculty via which forms are given to perceptions.
- Kant and Hume have both discussed the topic of space and time.

### Synthetic A-Priori Judgements

- The central point of Kant lies that a priori elements serve to increase empirical knowledge.
- Not the same as Metaphysics.
- Metaphysics as a science is not possible.
