
Kyoto Protocol & Carbon Trading

Kyoto Protocol

- Adopted on 11 December 1997
- Came in force on 16 February 2005
- COP7 at Marrakesh Rules for implementation were adopted & called "Marrakesh Accords."
- 1st commitment period started in 2008 and ended in 2012 GHG $\downarrow 5\%$ against 1990 level
- · Aim to reduce emissions
- 2012- Doha Amendments 2nd Commitment period 2013 to 2020 - GHG ↓ 18% against 1990 level

JI (Joint Implementation)

CDM (Clean Development Mechanism)

IET (International Emission Trading)

- Annex B Targets to limit emissions as "Assigned Amount Units (AAU)"
- Removal Unit (RMU): Based on land use, landuse change and forestry (LULUCF) activities like reforestation
- Emission Reduction Unit (ERU): By joint implementation
- Certified Emission Reduction (CER): By clean development mechanism
