➤ **Open drains**

- Include corrugated rubber or plastic sheets .
- Drain fluid collects in gauze pad or stoma bag .
- They increase the risk of infection.
- E.g. Penrose drain.



➤ **Closed drains**

- Consist of tubes draining into a bag or bottle.
- They include chest and abdominal drains.
- The risk of infection is reduced.
- E.g. Jackson-pratt drain.
